Primary Co-Owner(s)

Under the terms of this agreement, and for the sum of \$ _____ the primary co-owner(s) with whom the dog shall live, assume physical and financial responsibility and agree to terms 1 thru 15 as follows:

1. To take the dog to a Veterinarian of their choice within 48 hours of purchase and to furnish a copy of the health certificate to the Breeder, as proof of good health.
2. To provide proper health care and "housing". Cullen dogs are expected to live as family members and must not be confined to a garage, basement or similar restricted area as permanent quarters.
3. To provided adequate fencing and never allow the dog to be unleashed without adequate supervision.
4. Not to breed without consulting with Cullen regarding the quality of the proposed mate, and under no circumstances to breed to any animal the is not checked clear for hip dysplasia, progressive retinal atrophy (P.R.A.) and epilepsy , or is not registered with the American Kennel Club or other recognized governing body.
5. Agrees that Cullen _____ will not be bred unless proven free of hip dysplasia by radiograph and PRA by ophthalmologic examination.
6. Cullen _____ shall be returned to the Breeder at no cost should the primary co-owner be unable or unwilling to keep the dog. The dog may not be euthanized without consulting the Breeder.

7. The breeder must be notified of any change of address by the primary co-owner.
8. The primary co-owner agrees to follow health and feeding guidelines supplied by the Breeder at the time of purchase.
9. The Breeder guarantees that the sire and dam are X-Rayed clear of hip dysplasia and have been checked clear of P.R.A.
10. No replacement will be made for dogs sold as pets.
11. Replacement is guaranteed for dogs sold as show quality that develop hip dysplasia, P.R.A. or other serious congenital defects. In the event that such conditions are found, request for replacement must be made in writing and accompanied by a statement from a Veterinarian detailing the problem. A second opinion is required.
12. This agreement is made and signed by both the Seller (Breeder) and Purchaser to assure the well being and protection of Cullen _____ and to assure the health and quality of our Breed.
13. Failure to abide by this contract will result in the return of Cullen _____ to the Breeder and the payment of a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00.)
14. Any and all litigation that may arise will take place in the State in which Holly T Carr resides. Should this contract be breached by the primary co-owner, they will pay all court costs and legal expenses involved in the Breeder enforcing the contract.
15. Any modifications to this contract shall be made in writing and signed by all parties.

The Primary Co-owner acknowledges that this is a lifetime commitment to an animal with a potential lifespan of 16 years.
